

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

To help you  
Prepare for your Hunt

## **VISA REQUIREMENTS / INOCULATIONS**

- No visa is required for entry into Namibia. Your passport must be valid for 6 months.
- No inoculations are required. We advise clients to see that their tetanus shots are up to date. Our hunting farms fall outside high risk malaria areas, but the decision is yours. Please ask your medical practitioner.
- The company shall not be held liable for any cases of malaria.
- We carry first aid equipment, so you do not need to bring any. Obviously, should you require special medication, bring that with you.
- Make sure you have ample sun lotion with you.

## **RIFLE IMPORTS**

- Namibia is one of the most hunter friendly countries in Africa. You are allowed to bring as many rifles as you wish, with an allowance of a maximum of 80 rounds of ammo per rifle. Excluded semi-automatic and hand-guns.
- A minimum calibre in the range of 300 WinMag is required. (300 WinMag, 30-06, 308 etc) will be enough to knock down an antelope. Calibres smaller than this minimum can be used on certain species, but will not be allowed on larger species.
- Clients are responsible for the supply of their own ammunition.
- From the States for export arms permit contact Fish and Game Department.
- You will be required to fill out a Rifle Import / Export Application, which must be handed to the police at the airport.
- You can hire the rifle for US\$ 50, 00 per day. Excluding ammunition.

## **CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS**

- Most important is a pair of well broken in, ankle length boots. Bring a broad rimmed hat to protect neck and ears against the sun.
- Bring something warm for the evenings and early mornings, especially during our winter (June, July, and August). It gets cold at night!
- We prefer our clients to hunt in long pants and long sleeved shirts. Both as sun protection and general protection.

- Most of our bushes have thorns!
- Make sure you pack no bright colours – khaki and / or blue, green, etc will be best. Although we use camo in the bush, public use is reserved for police and military.
- Above all, travel light! We have daily laundry service in all our camps, which means yesterday's clothes will be available tomorrow.
- Our power supply is 220Volts. If you will require re-charging, make sure you bring an inverters and for any other electrical devices.

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### **DAILY RATES INCLUDE:**

- The services of a licensed professional hunter.
- Transfer from / to Windhoek Airport to Okarumuti Game Lodge.
- Tracker, skinner and camp staff.
- Full accommodation and catering.
- Daily laundry services.
- Skinning and field preparation of trophies. (For delivery to the taxidermist).
- Hunting vehicle and equipment for hunting.
- Delivery of trophies to a shipping agent / local taxidermist.
- Hunting licenses.

### **DAILY RATES DO NOT INCLUDED:**

- Trophy fees. (Note: wounded is regarded as shot and killed, and is charged to the hunter at the full trophy rate.)
- Value added tax. (15 % on daily rate only); levied by the State of Namibia
- Gratuities.
- Airfares.
- Cost of side trip.

- Personal expenses. Telephone and fax.
- Taxidermy.
- Packaging of trophy or skin.
- Trophy insurance, export permit and shipment.
- Personal insurance.

### **SAFARI CONFIRMATION:**

- A deposit, US\$ 1.000,00 per hunter, will be payable to confirm any booking. Payment must be settled in full one month before the safari start and made it either in cash, traveller's cheques or electronic transfer.
- No refunds on deposit will be made in case of cancellation of the safari.
- We reserve the right to change any terms, conditions and price without prior notice. Rates at the time of the hunt will be applied.
- On confirmation of the safari a contract will be signed when arriving in Namibia.

### **LIABILITY:**

- Whilst all reasonable precautions are taken to ensure the safety and good health of clients, no liability will be accepted for injury, illness and / or losses incurred during or after the safari.

### **TERMS OF SAFARI**

- Request a minimum of 7 days safari.
- Predator hunting minimum 14 days.
